Students Feedback Analysis and Action Taken 2017-18

1. About 11% of the responses recorded wanted an upgradation in the course content. The same was conveyed to the BoS and every year we upgrade and add quality to the syllabus.
2. Regarding teacher's knowledge and content comprehension, we received a few suggestions for the students like providing more scope for content comprehension etc. The same was conveyed to the faculty and apt steps were taken in the same direction. For ex: Remedial classes, extra classes etc
3. Regarding innovative teaching methods, quality teaching aids and use of ICT, maximum responses recorded were fully satisfied. A few however wanted more of interactive teaching methods. The same was conveyed to all the teachers. Better teacher aid and interactive teaching methods were focused upon
4. Majority of the responses recorded were totally happy with the course material provided by the teachers. Suggestions for the rest were considered and implemented
For eg: Availability of study material in the library
5. A few suggestions were got regarding the conduct of examination. Students wanted the introduction of different methods of internal evaluation. Taking into account the suggestions made we introduced the open book test and surprise tests
6. A few suggestions were received regarding extra curricular activities and study tours. A few students wanted more cultural competitions in the college. They also suggested that more study tours be organised. The same was taken into consideration.
We began focusing on arranging more extra curricular activities and study trips.

7. Around 15% of the responses recorded wanted a few more amenities in the health care centre like talks on health and other issues. The same was considered and we started with regular talks on health and hygiene for the students

8. Around 3.4% of the responses recorded had a few suggestions regarding security in the college. The suggestions were very minor and they were taken into consideration

9. Very good response was received regarding the conduct of seminars and workshops and being benefited by them. 10% had opted for the Good and Average options and their only suggestion was to have them for two days as finishing them in a single day was very hectic

10. Regarding skill based courses and Career & Competitive Guidance 92% were fully satisfied with the facilities provided to them. The remaining said that they wanted the above mentioned to be conducted during the college timings itself.

We have taken care to conduct the skill based courses after the lectures and career and competitive guidance during Sundays and holidays

11. Regarding classroom facilities and campus cleanliness, a few suggested having overhead projectors in a few class rooms and to plant more trees.

Both suggestions were received positively. Overhead projectors have been installed in two classrooms.

So also more trees have been planted in the campus.

12. 15% of the responses stated that they needed books on competitive exams in the library. The same was taken into consideration and more books on the same were purchased in the library

13. Regarding execution of programs a few stated that they should be informed about the organisation of programs well in advance so that they can be well prepared for the same. The same has been considered

14. Maximum students have stated that the administrative staff are very helpful and supportive. A few wanted a little flexibility regarding time. The same has been conveyed and all efforts are taken to help students with regards to time slots.

2017-18

1. Of the 74 responses recorded, we got a 100% positive response to aspects such as being alumni members, attending meetings, sharing a good rapport with the teachers and regarding the college environment
2. Regarding contribution towards the college, 22% stated that although not financially they would help in other ways like assisting in practice sessions of sports and cultural events and providing study material, etc. All the staff members motivated the alumni members to be more active and whole heartedly contribute towards the progress of the college

1. Out of the 22 responses recorded, 5% did not totally agree with the curriculum being relevant for employability. They opined that the curriculum should be practical and skill oriented. The same was conveyed to the concerned BoS section. Efforts were made to introduce the same through the Board of Studies in English
2. 7% were not fully satisfied with the relevance of the syllabus in present times. Suggestions were taken from them and the focus was on job oriented syllabus

7. A few responded (6%) that there is more scope for improvement and a need to accept criticism in a positive manner. The faculty members were guided regarding the need to be flexible, open to constructive criticism and space for improvement.

Students Feedback Analysis and Action Taken 2021 - 2022

1. A few responses recorded wanted an upgradation in the course content. The same was conveyed to the BoS and every year we upgrade and add quality to the syllabus.
2. Regarding teacher's knowledge and content comprehension, we received a few suggestions for the students like making the course content more comprehension. The same was conveyed to the faculty and apt steps were taken in the same direction. Use of bilingual explanation, Bridge courses, remedial classes were conducted.
3. Regarding innovative teaching methods, quality teaching aids and use of ICT, maximum responses recorded were fully satisfied. A few stated that online mode of teaching was good. The same was conveyed to all the teachers. From this year we adopted the blended mode of teaching.
4. The majority of the responses recorded were totally happy with the course material provided by the teachers. Suggestions were considered and implemented.
For eg: Availability of books, reference material, question banks etc
5. A few suggestions were obtained regarding the conduct of the examination. A few students wanted the introduction of orals as a part of the internal examination. The same has been introduced in addition to other assessment methods.
6. A few suggestions were received regarding extra curricular activities and study tours. A few suggested that there should be more study tours and industrial visits with good participation. The same has been taken into consideration.
7. Of the responses recorded, 6% wanted workshops on health related issues. The same was considered and we have organised workshops on yoga, Art of Living etc

8. Around 6% of the responses recorded had a few suggestions regarding security in the college. The suggestions were very minor and they were taken into consideration
9. Very good response was received regarding the conduct of seminars and workshops and being benefited by them. 2% had opted for the Good and Average options and their only suggestion was to organise syllabus based seminars and workshops
10. Regarding skill based courses and Career & Competitive Guidance the majority were fully satisfied with the facilities provided to them. The remaining said that they wanted a few lectures on interview skills. The same has been done on a priority basis
11. Regarding classroom facilities and campus cleanliness, a few suggested that the classrooms be upgraded with modern technology. Taking into consideration the suggestion, overhead projectors have been installed in a few more classrooms.
12. 8% of the responses stated that they needed more books other than the ones based on the syllabus. The same was taken into consideration and made available in the library
13. Regarding execution of programs a few stated that more programs based on skill development should be organised throughout the year. Efforts have been taken to consider the same. We have started a number of certificate course in skill development
14. Maximum students have stated that the administrative staff are very helpful and supportive. A few suggestions were got. The same has been conveyed and all efforts are taken to help students with regards to the same.

Alumni Feedback Analysis and Action Taken

2021 - 2022

1. Of the 80 responses recorded, we got a 100% positive response to aspects such as being alumni members, attending meetings, sharing a good rapport with the teachers and regarding the college environment
2. Regarding contribution towards the college, 16% stated that although not financially they would help in other ways like assisting in practice sessions of sports and cultural events and providing study material, etc. All the staff members motivated the alumni members to be more active and whole heartedly contribute towards the progress of the college
3. Out of the responses recorded, 10 % stated that the college curriculum has not contributed totally towards their personality development. Discussions were held at length and the same was taken up in BoS
4. Out of the responses recorded, 16% were not fully satisfied with the competency of the faculty. After discussing with the present members regarding the same, their views were taken into consideration. The same was conveyed to the faculty with a need to make improvements wherever necessary
5. Regarding Educational resources 4% were not completely satisfied with the same. They expressed the need to increase the library timings specially during the exams. The same was communicated to the Librarian and now the library is open even on Sundays and holidays during the examination period.
6. As many as 8% had minor complaints about the college like the need to beautify the campus and plant more trees.
The same was communicated to the NSS Coordinator. Faculty and Students were motivated to personally contribute towards the same. A number of plants have been planted, we have an ozone area, no plastic campus and are still in the process of beautifying our campus.

7. Regarding the overall rating of the college, a few suggested that along with the prescribed syllabus, the students need to be aided in getting practical knowledge about various job skills and be financially stable. The same year we started with 23 new skill based certificate courses and 917 students enrolled for different certificate courses.
